



## Visa Information guideline to apply for:

# **Temporary Work Subclass 400 Short Stay Specialist**



#### Who needs this visa?

Media - Print/Website/Radio - International Audience (excluding Australian Audience)

e.g. Journalist, Photographer, Radio commentator, Editor

### Applying directly with the Department of Home Affairs

To apply directly with Australia's Department of Home Affairs (DHA), you will need to:

- 1. Create an account through ImmiAccount (the online platform for Australian visa applications)
- 2. Select the visa type
- 3. Complete the visa application form
- 4. Attach the required documents
  - Please make sure you attach:
    - Passport clear colour copy of the photo page of your passport. If your current passport is close to expiry, you can still use it however you must upload your new one later through your ImmiAccount or you may be refused boarding an aircraft.
    - Letter of Invitation from Tennis Australia click here to request your Letter
    - Other requested documents you can find a list at the end of this document
- 5. Pay the application fee
- 6. Submit the application

Important: please do not include anyone on your visa application. Each traveller will need to apply for their own visa.

# **Biometrics Request**



Media – Print/Website/Radio participants are not eligible for the biometrics waiver and as a part of lodging a visa application in a country included in the biometrics program, regardless of nationality, you might need to provide your biometrics in relation to each visa application you lodge.

After you submit your visa application online, the Department of Home Affairs may request your biometrics via an automated email. You must arrange an appointment at the nearest biometric office so they can be collected.

The nominated biometrics collection agency will capture a facial image with a digital camera and a 10-digit fingerprint scan with a digital finger scanner. To check, click here.






## Selecting the right visa in your online application

Select the correct visa: when you apply online using an ImmiAccount through the Department of Home Affairs, ensure you select the correct visa:

· Select 'Temporary Work (Activity)' then select 'Temporary Work - Short Stay Specialist Visa (400)' as illustrated below:





### **Completing the application**

- Respond carefully and truthfully to all questions and ensure you provide the answer that best applies to your circumstances
- Read carefully and complete the Declaration on page 24
- Upload the documents required. Failure to do so will delay your application
- Your visa application answers must be in English

### Attach the required documents to apply for a SC400 visa?

When you apply for your visa, you <u>must\_attach</u>:

- Letter of Invitation from Tennis Australia click here to request your letter.
- Passport: a clear colour copy of the photo page of your passport.

If your current passport is close to expiry, you can still use it; however, you must upload your new passport later through your ImmiAccount before travelling, as visas are digitally linked to the passport used when applying for the visa. If you do not notify the Department of Home Affairs of your new passport, it will not be linked to your visa, and you may experience issues or delays at the border or when boarding an aircraft.

- · Letter from your overseas employer explaining your current position and duties undertaken whilst in Australia.
- Travel and Stay Itinerary
- · Contract or other proof of engagement for the Australian Open 2025 or Australian Summer of Tennis: you must have a letter confirming your performance or work in Australia from a player or Australian company. Details should include your position, duties, or project of work you will undertake, the duration of your work, the reason why you are in Australia.

There are additional documents that you will need to include to support your application. See 'Gather your documents' at: Subclass 400 Temporary Work (Short Stay Specialist) visa (homeaffairs.gov.au)

After you attach the above documents, there will be a pop-up window asking you why you have not attached all of the documents they requested for Financial & Health. In this case, answer: Please see the invitation letter attached.

Note: failure to attach documents such as your passport and Letter of Invitation will delay your application.
